#### 33/14 <u>Management Accounts for Development Committee: 2014/15 – Projected</u> Outturn for Quarter 1

The Committee considered a report by the Executive Manager – Finance (F-043-F), which enabled the review of financial performance of services within its remit.

The Executive Manager – Finance summarised the main terms of the report. Members noted the projected outturn position of  $\pounds$ 554,000 underspend at year end, and the main variances as outlined in the appendices to the report.

In making reference to the reported underspend, the Chair advised on the anticipated uptake on economic development grant schemes when the ESF funding streams reopen later this year. The Executive Manager – Economic Development advised on the process whereby the Council, as the lead partner for the LEADER Action Group, is to demonstrate the match funding element of £2m by the end of August 2014. Match funding will also be needed to cover the ESF, European Fisheries Fund and other funding streams. He added that, compared to this time last year, there has been a small increase in uptake of economic grant schemes, however that uptake is still less than projected due to the current economic climate.
