LSO comments:

There is a general legislative requirement to protect public health and there exists the possibility of alcohol being consumed for a prolonged period, potentially between 8am and the 11pm terminal hour. However, committee members of the club have stated that although they are permitted to serve alcohol from 11am they only do this at weekends. This event at Sandwick is well run and the extended opening hours until 11am granted last year caused no reported issues. I therefore have no objections to the application based on the assumption that the event will be run in a similar responsible fashion by the club.
