(a)	The Co-operative Group Food Ltd The Board were advised that Ms L Knarston, representative of the Co-operative Group Food Ltd., and Mr A Hamilton, the proposed store Manager, were in attendance.	GRANTED
	The Solicitor introduced the application, where he advised that the Co-operative Group are building new premises in Brae adjacent to their existing store, which is progressing at pace. The Licence held by the existing Co-operative would be surrendered when the new premises are operational. He advised that the capacity has been agreed by Building Standards, and this is a routine application for standard off sales opening hours.
