2	<u>Application for Extension of Licensed Hours</u>	<u>Decision</u>
(a)	<p><u>Sandwick Social Club</u></p> <p>A representative of the applicant was in attendance.</p> <p>After hearing the Solicitor introduce the application, Mr Robinson moved that the Board approve the grant of the extension of licensed hours for 9am to 11am on 1 February 2017. Mr Duncan seconded. During the discussion, the Licensing Standards Officer confirmed that the bar will close at 11am, and would open again later that evening.</p> <p>The Licensing Standards Officer, in referring to the comments as submitted, clarified that the first bullet point should read, “.....there exists the possibility of alcohol being consumed for a prolonged period, potentially between 9am and the 11pm terminal hours”.</p> <p>In response to a question regarding the observation made that the Social Club “has permission to serve alcohol from 11am but only do this at weekends”, the Licensing Standards Officer advised from the general comment that had been made to indicate the fact that this is a well run Club. In that regard, she advised that Committee Members of the Club could opt to open the Club every day at 11am, but they choose not to.</p> <p>Mr Duncan commented that the Social Club was well run, and the breakfast following Lerwick Up Helly Aa was a well organised event.</p>	Granted
