1.0 Decisions / Action Required:

- 1.1 That the Partnership **RESOLVES to: -**
 - 1.1.1 **APPROVE** the proposed alterations to public bus service timetables, in line with the Shetland Island Council's implementation of the Common Timetable Structure for Secondary Education;
 - 1.1.2 **APPROVE** the proposed formal amendment to the approved 2018/19 budget of £50k in both income and expenditure, with an overall net impact to ZetTrans of zero; and
 - 1.1.3 That the Partnership **INSTRUCTS** the Lead Officer or his nominee to make all necessary arrangements and take all action necessary to implement the Decision taken.

2.0 High Level Summary:

- 2.1 On 21 February 2018, the Shetland Islands Council agreed to continue to proceed towards implementation of a common timetable structure in May 2018.
- 2.2 This proposed change will necessitate amendments to be made to the opening and closing times of secondary schools across Shetland.
- 2.3 From Tuesday 29th May 2018, secondary school pupils utilising the public bus service in order to travel to and from the Anderson High School, Mid Yell Junior High School and Sandwick Junior High School will no longer be able to use services which do not correlate with the amended opening and closing times of the schools. This may also impact on members of the public travelling to these schools where their journey needs to align with the opening and closing times of the schools.
- 2.4 The purpose of this report therefore is to present proposals for the alteration of public bus service budgets and timetables to enable their continued use by secondary school pupils and to seek the Partnership's approval to proceed with implementing these alterations and to seek authority to carry out any actions required to implement that decision.
- 2.5 The additional cost of these changes to Public Bus Services will be met by an increased contribution from Shetland Islands Council.

3.0 Corporate Priorities and Joint Working:

3.1 ZetTrans' overarching policy is to have in place transport arrangements that are affordable and meet people's needs, within available resources. To achieve this, ZetTrans works closely with its member bodies of Shetland Islands Council, NHS Shetland and Highlands and Islands Enterprise.

4.0 Key Issues:

- 4.1 On 21 February 2018, Shetland Islands Council agreed to "proceed towards implementation of the common timetable structure in May 2018, taking into account the school transport costs", with the additional costs being met by Children's Services.
- 4.2 In order to facilitate the continued use of public bus services for school transport journeys, from the implementation date of the common timetable structure for secondary education, it is necessary to make alterations to some public bus service timetables. The proposed alterations are detailed in Appendix 1.

5.0 Exempt and/or confidential information:

6.0 Implications :	
6.1 Service Users, Patients and Communities:	Consultation has been carried out with passengers on the affected services. Responses received do not indicate that there would be any change in patronage resulting from the proposed timetable alterations detailed in Appendix 1.
6.2 Human Resources and Organisational Development:	There are no implications arising from this report.
6.3 Equality, Diversity and Human Rights:	There are no implications arising from this report.
6.4 Legal:	There are no implications arising from this report. Changes to contracts are undertaken in consultation with Legal Services.
6.5 Finance:	The proposed changes to Public Bus Services in Shetland as outlined in this report are estimated to cost an additional £50k. This amount covers the additional contract costs as a result of the required changes (£37k) and associated printing, advertising costs and service registration fees (£13k). This additional cost will be added to the approved budgets for Public Bus Service costs and the Contribution from Shetland Islands Council.

6.9 Risk Management:	The risk identified relates to the 'do nothing' option. If public bus service timetables were not altered in line with the changes proposed in Appendix 1, the current level of patronage and income from the school pupils would not be achieved. This would increase the net cost of the public bus service network.		
6.10 Policy and Delegated Authority:	ZetTrans' policy is to seek to have in place transport arrangements that meet people's needs and that can be afforded in the medium term. To achieve this policy, ZetTrans works closely with Shetland Islands Council.
