

## Sailing

Six weeks of dinghy sailing at Delting Boating Club, for young people aged 8-14 years, starting Monday 7th July and ending on Friday 15th August. There will be a morning session (9.30-12.30pm) and an afternoon session (1.30-4.30pm) each day, with a maximum of 6 participants in each session - ie 12 youngsters for the day. All sessions will be led by an RYA Senior Instructor.

At the end of each week of sailing, each participant could expect to gain at least the RYA Junior Stage 1 sailing award. No prior sailing experience is necessary although youngsters should be confident in the water. They should be prepared to get wet and bring a complete change of clothes and shoes.

Cost per participant is £65 per week for 15 hours of tuition (e.g. five morning or afternoon sessions).
