

Activity Sheet - Carve your own stone!

Materials required: Clay, rubber, soap or polystyrene; carving utensils; paints; paper in squares or triangles to use as 'bunting', or in poster size.

Materials provided: Runic alphabet poster - this can be displayed in the classroom for all to see.

Method: Use clay, rubber, soap or polystyrene as your stone, and carve one or a few runes into it using your carving kit! You can paint the stone, and leave the carved rune unpainted, or you can paint the carved rune a different colour.

Or you could use the painted stone as a 'stamp' by pressing it in coloured ink - these can be collected by the teacher and displayed as a banner across the room!

Or you could stamp your rune onto a poster, and you can explain on the poster what runes are and what your rune means.
