




The Runic Alphabet



There are various different versions of the Runic alphabet, from different time periods. Runes also varied depending on where they were used.

These are Elder Futhark runes. They are the oldest version of the runic alphabet.







This is 'Younger Futhark'. It evolved from Elder Futhark to become the main alphabet used in Scandinavia. This version is from Norway.

The Younger Futhark alphabet was used from around 800AD to about 1200AD (the Viking Age).

Did you know? The Runic alphabet didn't include the letter 'c' - they used a 'k' instead!
