

Shetland Islands Council, recognising its role as a major employer in the islands, has in place a Graduate Placement Scheme. The scheme aims to provide new degree level graduates with a broad experience of the provision of local government services in Shetland. We are able to offer a range of 12-month placements across a variety of Council service areas, suitable for a wide range of degree subjects.

These placements offer work experience, as well as a programme of training and development opportunities. Whilst there is no guarantee of continued employment at the end of the placement, participants are able to apply for internal posts, which arise during their placement.

The Scheme is usually advertised in June each year and applicants need to have graduated within a 12-month period of the advertisement.
