

**SHETLAND ISLANDS AREA LICENSING BOARD – MEETING 22 APRIL 2011****1. Application for Extension of Licensed Hours**

LSO comments: This application is inconsistent with the following provisions of the Shetland Islands Area Licensing Board's Statement of Licensing Policy.

12.6 – Extended hours applications may be granted, where the Board considers it appropriate, in connection with a special event of local significance. The Tall Ships event is certainly an event of local significance. However, the event itself is not operating at this time of the night, even on the weekend nights.

20.4 – The guideline terminal hours are 1am on weeknights and 2am on weekend nights for premises which, in terms of the operating plan and the Board's understanding, will be operating as nightclubs. This premises already has a terminal hour of 2am on weekend nights and 1am on weekday nights.

Therefore the Board may wish to consider whether it is appropriate to grant this extended hours application given that the event to which it states a connection to is not operating at that time of night and that the premises already has a licence to the latest ordinarily permitted terminal hours.

Police comments: I confirm that although we have no formal objections we would submit an observation that the times applied for are outwith the Shetland Islands Area Licensing Board Policy.
