### **Number of Occasional Extensions, Occasional Licences and Occasional Permissions Granted Under Delegated Authority**

The Board considered and noted a report by the Clerk to the Board detailing occasional extensions, licences and permissions granted since the last quarterly meeting of the Board in January 2008 (Appendix 1). Copies of the report were circulated at the meeting.

### **Report by the Clerk to the Board Detailing Applications for Regular Extension of Permitted Hours and Occasional Extension of Permitted Hours**

The Board considered the applications detailed in the list prepared by the Clerk to the Board and took decisions thereon as shown in Appendix 2.

During consideration of the applications for Occasional Extensions, all relating to the Brae Up Helly Aa, the Board noted that previous Board decisions relating to rural Up Helly Aa events had been restricted to 2 a.m., but with no restriction on admission. Accordingly, and after hearing representation from the representative for the Brae Hall, the Board agreed, on the motion of Mr J Budge, seconded by Mr G Robinson, to be consistent with its decisions, and therefore to also restrict these applications to 2 a.m., with no curfew on admissions.

### **Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 – Statement of Licensing Policy**

The Board considered a report by the Clerk to the Board (Appendix 3).

The Depute Clerk provided a short introduction to the report. The Board noted that the Northern Constabulary and the Fire Brigade were happy with the content of the policy document.
