

Shetland Islands Council Cullivoe Pier



Cullivoe harbour is situated on the North end of Yell, North Shetland in position 60°42' N 01°00' W and has 250m of modern well fendered quay space with sheltered deep-water berths for vessels up to 6.0m draft.

Services including cranes, fuel, stores, diving, water and engineering are available 24 hours through local agents. Heavy road transport is available Shetland wide via modern roads and ferry services. There are extensive hard quayside lay down areas for equipment import, assembly and maintenance.

Cullivoe is a popular port for salmon farm operations with potential for all kinds of fish processing. Nearby Bluemull Sound, with strong tidal currents, offers good potential for tidal, wind and wave power generation, making Cullivoe a viable location for businesses servicing the renewable power generation industry.

- Cullivoe is a short distance from the North and South entrances to Bluemull Sound which has potential for wave and tide power generation.
- Salmon and shellfish processing industries regularly use Cullivoe.
- The Shetland Islands Council (SIC) operates a fleet of tugs and workboats, which are available by arrangement, for towage and harbour support services.
- Bluemull Sound has tidal currents of 4 kts to 6 kts offering potential for marine tidal power generation.
- A prototype 30 kilowatt tidal energy device, designed and built by Edinburgh-based Nova Innovations, with the help of local firm Shetland Composites, is currently planned in the area.
