

Sullom Voe Terminal Site Standards

Sullom Voe Terminal processes and stores large volumes of highly flammable material and is thus classified as a “Top Tier Hazard Site” under the Control of Major Accident Hazards (COMAH) regulations 1999. In order that we may keep everyone safe it is vital that we adopt the highest possible Health, Safety and Environmental Standards, The following Standards are designed to ensure the safety of everyone on, and passing through the Terminal.

Prohibited equipment

Matches, lighters, mobile telephones, cameras, batteries and any similar battery/electrical equipment or sources of ignition must not be taken outside the ships accommodation or on to the Terminal. Alcohol, drugs, knives and weapons are also prohibited on the Terminal.

(Offsigners must have such items switched off and contained in their baggage. Security tape, supplied by the ships agent, must be used to secure the baggage)

Personal Protective Equipment

All personnel on the terminal must comply with the minimum personal protective equipment requirements.

All ships crew when ashore must wear:

Flame – retardant overalls, Safety footwear, Glasses, Hard hat and gloves.

(Small children, or very small persons for who PPE would be oversized and therefore cause a hazard, are exempt from this rule)

To assist crewmembers taking shore leave, a drop off point for their PPE is located at the Jetty Foreshore building.

Terminal Security Officers will search all crewmembers to ensure that the above safety measures are enforced.
