

**SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCIL  
(B9074 EAST VOE, SCALLOWAY AND TRONDRA BRIDGE) (40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT)  
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2012**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCIL propose to make the above named Order under Section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

1. The general effect of the Order would be that no person would be permitted to drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding FORTY MILES PER HOUR on the length of road described in Paragraph 1 of the Schedule appended hereto.
2. The provisions of the following existing Road Traffic Orders would be revoked to the extent hereinafter specified :
  - (a) "Shetland Islands Council (B9074 East Voe Road and Trondra Bridge) (30 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2010" in its entirety.
3. A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the length of road affected and the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at Roads Service, Gremista, Lerwick during normal office hours.
4. Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order must send an objection in writing to the undersigned by 11 January 2013. Objections should state the name and address of the objector, the matter to which their objections relate and the grounds on which they are made.

SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCIL, in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 of the said Act, hereby make the following Order :

1. This Order may be cited as the "Shetland Islands Council (B9074 East Voe, Scalloway and Trondra Bridge) (40 Miles per Hour Speed Limit) Traffic Regulation Order 2012" and will come into effect on [REDACTED] 2013.
2. With effect from the date on which this Order becomes operational, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding FORTY MILES PER HOUR on the length of road described in Paragraph 1 of the Schedule and shown cross-hatched in blue on the plan, Drawing No. P27/2012, both annexed and executed as relative to this Order.
3. The provisions of the following existing Road Traffic Orders are hereby revoked to the extent hereinafter specified :
  - a) "Shetland Islands Council (B9074 East Voe Road and Trondra Bridge) (30 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2010" in its entirety.
4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or by or under any other enactment.
