1.	<u>Application for Premises Licence</u>	<u>Decision</u>
(a)	<p><u>Fetlar General Merchants</u></p> <p>The Solicitor introduced the report and the Board noted that no comments or objections had been received. A layout plan was tabled at the meeting for consideration.</p> <p>Mr Cooper moved that the Board approve the grant of a Premises Licence. Mr Smith seconded.</p>	GRANTED
2	<p><u>Application for Variation other than a Minor Variation of Premises Licence</u></p>	
(a)	<p><u>Da Steak Hoose Limited</u></p> <p>The Solicitor introduced the report and advised that there were no changes in terms of the layout plan. It was proposed to amend the times that under-18s were allowed entry, and there was also a change in terms of capacity, which had increased to 57 for both the café and bar. Building Standards had no objections to this increase in capacity.</p> <p>Responding to questions, the Solicitor advised that he could not confirm if Building Standards had inspected the building.</p>	GRANTED

	<p>However they had indicated to him that they were satisfied with the change to the capacity, and had not submitted any objections as part of the consultation process.</p> <p>Mr Scott moved that the Board approve the application for a Variation other than a Minor Variation of a Premises Licence, in its entirety. Mr Cooper seconded, and the Board concurred.</p>	
3.	<u>Application for Occasional Licence</u>	
(a)-(e)	<p><u>Sukhdev Gurung</u></p> <p>The Solicitor introduced the report, advising that the application related to on-sales licences for the new restaurant in the premises, and would cover the premises for the period up to 6 February 2018. A Premises Licence application had been submitted, and would be considered in due course.</p> <p>Mr Smith moved that the Board approve the applications for Occasional Licence in their entirety, and Ms Wishart seconded.</p>	GRANTED
