**CPPW01:** Chaltister Ness Walk  
 Difficulty: moderate to locally challenging  
 Surface: tarred road, grass and heather  
 Attraction: coastal scenery

**CPPW02:** Pettigarth field  
 Difficulty: moderate to locally challenging  
 Surface: heather surface  
 Attraction: off road link between two communities, Skaw and Isbister as well as providing access to archaeological remains

**CPPW03:** Loch of Houll  
 Difficulty: easy  
 Surface: grass track  
 Attraction: community route and also used for sailing model boats

**CPPW04:** Ward of Clett and Hevda Field  
 Difficulty: moderate to locally challenging  
 Surface: gravel and tarred tracks, heather surface  
 Attraction: coastal Scenery and high viewpoints

The Core Paths in Whalsay consist of routes for community use, scenic routes both coastal and view points and access to its main archaeological sites.
