Two applications were received-

11.0 SPEED LIMITS IN SOUTH NESTING

An email had been received through Community Development Company Nesting (CDCN) from a local resident regarding the speed of traffic in South Nesting.

There is a speed limit in place from Freester to the school, but as the busiest part of the road runs from the Catfirth junction to the shop this part of the road is not covered. The Scrapstore and new housing scheme being built at Catfirth has seen and will add to the traffic on the road.

It was decided to contact Neil Hutcheson at SIC Roads Service to advise of the situation and concerns, and ask if he wants to come to a meeting.
