

SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCIL
(KING HARALD STREET - LERWICK CENTRAL) (20 MILES PER HOUR ZONE)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER P32/2025

NOTICE is hereby given that SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCIL propose to make the above named Order under Section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

1. The general effect of the proposed Order is that no person shall drive, cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding TWENTY MILES PER HOUR on the following roads:
 - (i) A969 SCALLOWAY ROAD from 15 metres East of its junction with King Harald Street to a point 20 metres West of its junction with King Harald Street, a distance of 35 metres or thereby.
 - (ii) A969 COMMERCIAL ROAD from its junction with King Harald Street in a Westerly direction to its junction with Burgh Road, a distance of 58 metres or thereby.
 - (iii) A969 NORTH ROAD from its junction with Burgh Road in a Westerly direction to a point 16 metres West of Garthspool Road, a distance of 79 metres or thereby.
 - (iv) KING HARALD STREET from A969 Commercial Road in a Southerly direction to A969 Scalloway Road, a distance of 595 metres or thereby.
 - (v) That length of road next to BROWN'S BUILDINGS, formerly part of High Street, running from King Harald Street to A969 Commercial Road/ A969 North Road at Burgh Road, a distance of 40 metres or thereby.
2. A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road affected and the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Roads Service Offices, Gremista, Lerwick ZE1 0PX during normal office hours. 3. Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order must send an objection in writing to the undersigned by 10 October 2025. Objections should state the name and address of the objector, the matter to which their objections relate, and the grounds on which they are made.
