

SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCIL
(A968 VOE) (30 MILES PER HOUR AND 40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMITS)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER P07/2026

NOTICE is hereby given that SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCIL propose to make the above named Order under Section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

1. The general effect of the proposed Order is that no person shall drive, cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding THIRTY MILES PER HOUR on the A968 VOE TO TOFT ROAD from the A970 at Tagon, Voe to North of Norderhoull, Voe, or at a speed exceeding FORTY MILES PER HOUR on the A968 VOE TO TOFT ROAD from North of Norderhoull to North of "Norville".
2. A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road affected and the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Roads Service Offices, Gremista, Lerwick ZE1 0PX during normal office hours. Details will also be published on the Council web site.
3. Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order must send an objection in writing to the undersigned by 12 June 2026. Objections should state the name and address of the objector, the matter to which their objections relate, and the grounds on which they are made.
