Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005

SEA Post-Screening Determination Statement

Core Path Plan (Review)

The Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005 requires responsible authorities to determine if a plan or programme is likely to have a significant environmental impact. In regard to the preparation and adoption of Shetland's Core Path Plan (Review), Shetland Islands Council is a responsible authority in terms of the 2005 Act.

As required, Shetland Islands Council has prepared a summary of its views on the likely significant environmental effects of Shetland's Core Path Plan (Review) and consulted Historic Environment Scotland, the Scottish Environment Protection Agency and Scottish Natural Heritage (the Consultation Authorities) on this.

In line with the Consultation Authorities comments Shetland Islands Council has determined that the Core Path Plan (Review) is unlikely to have any significant environmental effects, therefore an SEA will not be required.
