The Old Dock

Condition of old docks was surveyed in August 2021 arranged by AI, no reports shared to date on findings of survey. WCC highlighted that subsidence was worse and becoming dangerous. 22.08.2022 Hazel Sutherland will bring up topic with SIC again and proposed visit to Whalsay.

Dredging

The dredging has been held up by unforeseen circumstances. JL requested that they be kept appraised of any potential developments in the Marina area. No update since 26th Oct 2021, work still incomplete. RT would also follow up to see if new anchors can be replaced at the same time as dredging.
