

## Active Travel Options to the Shetland Climate Festival

The SIC Climate Change Programme Teams have made significant efforts to keep the carbon emissions associated with the event as low as possible. One way for us to do this was to locate the event in Lerwick, at the Clickimin Leisure Complex, as this area is well served by bus routes and main roads which gives folk more options to use active travel or public transport to join us at the event. This also meant that those with decreased mobility that are reliant on a personal vehicle would be able to travel to a central location using main roads which, in many cases, reduces the total fuel consumption.

### **Cycling**

Shetland is served by a network of well serviced roads, making this an excellent transport option for a range of bikes and users. There are spaces available at Clickimin to secure your bike once you have arrived.

There is a bus stop directly outside Clickimin which is served by the below bus services:

#### [1 – Lerwick Town Service](#)

This bus will be able to collect you from the Viking Bus Station or most other stops around Lerwick that link with other bus routes.

#### [6 – Lerwick to Sumburgh, South Mainland](#)

This bus is ideal for those travelling from the South Mainland into Lerwick as it stops right by the entrance to Clickimin.
