7.1 TRANSPORT- FERRIES

Clerk sent an email with following issues raised and that members are willing to meet to discuss the same. Festive Timetable, Docking Schedule/Docking Timetable, Ferry notice board, Updating of voicebank, Sunday timetable, Discounted cards, Meeting in September minutes. No reply has been received to date.

COMMUNITY HIRE FERRIES

7.2 ROADS

West Sandwick Beach Road/Graveyard Road

Cullivoe Road

An update from the project design has been received from Ian Leask, Design Engineer of Roads Service, the detailed design is largely complete. Land plans are all complete and have verbal agreements from all the landowners for the purchase of the plots required for the project.

Burravoe Footpath

Update has been received and Systra are awaiting topographic mapping and 3D datasets designs.

Road at Andersville corner

Clerk reported to Roads service.

Camb cattle grid sides

Damaged cattle grid sides has been reported to roads service.

North Brough Road sign

Road sign to North Brough, poles have rusted away and sign is lying on ground and can't be seen, Clerk to contact Roads to replace poles or remove the sign.

Grids at Gloup, Midbrake and Barriers at Cottages Brig, Cullivoe.

Cllr Robert Thomson has reported grids at Gloup and Cottages at Midbrake also Crash barriers that have been broken for a considerable time and held back with posts.

7.3 NET ZERO CARBON NEUTRAL ISLAND (YELL) PROJECT

There is a Carbon Neutral Yell consultation event in Mid Yell hall tonight and one in Cullivoe Hall tomorrow afternoon along with delegates from Community Energy Scotland to answer questions and feedback for Yell's Climate Action Plan.

7.5 BRECKON BEACH

Two ideas were discussed with Michael Duncan and it is planned that the SIC apply to Coastal Community Fund before 31st March for funding towards replacing the steps. Consent will need to be gained from Nature Scot due to the SSSI.

7.6 ABANDONED VEHICLE

Details passed on to EH and EH served notices on a Diahatsu, a Citroen and a Toyota when up in North Isles on 17th January.

7.7 YCC LAPTOP

Options for laptop were discussed, investigate price and funding to be allocated out of next year's funding.

7.8 LIST OF BUSINESSES IN YELL

List of businesses drawn up in 2020 was discussed and to be upgraded, All members to look at changes before next meeting. Clerk to collate changes to list.

7.9 COMMUNITY HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE

Following the meeting with the Community Health and social Care directorate, a discussion was had on what can be done by the Community Council offer to help with recruitment by

putting up advertising notices, could the empty rooms in Isleshavn be used for housing agency workers, follow up meeting to discuss what can be done, Developing the Young Workforce could include care type work

7.10 COMMUNITY RESILIENCE

Following the snow and associated power cuts in December, local halls opened for assistance but it would be useful to draw up contingency plans which included community resilience as CC were well placed to understand their communities.

7.11 REGIONAL TRANSPORT STRATEGY(RTS) FOR SHETLAND

ZetTrans has produced a new Draft Regional Transport Strategy for the Shetland Islands and is seeking views and feedback on the Strategy. The information gathered through the survey will be used to update and finalise the RTS. Mr L Odie and Mrs A Jamieson to complete feedback for YCC.

7.12 SCOTLAND'S BEACH AWARDS 2023 APPLICATION

Apply for award for West Sandwick, Mrs A Jamieson shall work on completing the application form.

7.13 BURIALS/FUNERALS

Winter scheduling in place which allows interments to be completed within daylight hours to ensure the safety of operatives and carried out to a high standard. Winter scheduling runs from when clocks go back in October to the end of January.

7.14 BOTTLE BANKS

The Shetland Islands Council are aware that the bottle banks in Yell need emptying and the contractor has them on his list to be emptied as a priority, bottle banks have now been emptied but debris left around the banks. Deposit return scheme for glass drinks bottles and drinks cans is to be implemented in August. This may mean that bottle bank requirements will be less in future.

7.15 BEAW FIELD WIND FARM

An update had been received that the Scottish Ministers have granted the variation for an extension of the operational period from 25 years to 40 years.
