Proposed Amendments to the Council's Scheme for the Establishment of Community Councils

NOTICE is hereby given, that Shetland Islands Council (hereinafter the '**Council**'), in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 53(1) of the above mentioned Act, proposes to revoke the existing Community Council Scheme of Establishment and make a new Scheme for the Establishment of Community Councils in Shetland. This review will involve at least three public consultations and further Special Meetings of the Council. Further details are available on the Council website at www.shetland.gov.uk/ccschemereview.

A Special Meeting of the Council, held on 3 October 2023, agreed to a public consultation exercise on the proposed revocation and replacement of the current Scheme. In the first of these consultations, the Council now invites suggestions and representations from the public on the current areas and composition of the Community Councils under the current Scheme.

The initial consultation process will be held over one 12-week period and one 10-week period. The first consultation period shall address the '**Plan of Community Councils' Areas and Composition**' and the second period shall address the Scheme itself, together with associated documentation. A final 6-week period of consultation will be held prior to adoption of any amendments.
