10/23/03 MATTERS ARISING

BRECKON BEACH

6.1 TRANSPORT - FERRIES

Recent disruptions on Yell Sound & Bluemull Sound were discussed and it was agreed to ask for a meeting with Sellaness or ask the team to come to a YCC meeting. Staffing issues, complaints about service lately, training programme, single vessel bookings or shuttle timetable, agency staff/local pay rates, advertise that travellers with appointments to make themselves known to crew. If cones are out please use an unbooked queue. Bluemull Sound affects Yell as well as Yell Sound as workers and businesses using the service.

Community Hire Ferry

The crew are unable to accommodate the late hire that was requested by the Yell Show Committee on 19th November. reply to be sent to Sellaness that we are disappointed with this and what happens if there is an emergency in Unst or Fetlar that evening.

6.2 ROADS

No update has been received regarding recent issues reported but some of the work has been carried out.

Road at West Yell from Nortaburn to Ulsta hall was shelved from tarring this year, email Roads that this road gets priority in 2024.

The Wart, Mid Yell road is closed during the evenings for the fibre works to be carried out.

A copy of a letter sent to SIC Roads by Jennifer Christie regarding the Gossabrough road, it was noted and we await the SIC's response.

7.1 WINTER/RURAL BUS SHELTERS

Following an email to roads from Capt Gray regarding the bus stop at Aywick with the base crumbling, no ramp and no gate to keep the sheep out and cracked panels. Roads have placed a purchase order for the provision of a new concrete base and ramp, the cracked panels will also be replaced. Following discussion it was agreed to investigate gates for the bus shelters that require them to keep out the sheep. New bus shelter was proposed for Mid Yell pier for folk using the east route, perhaps it's something that could be included in the Mid Yell Development Group's new toilets.

7.2 COMMUNITY COUNCIL SCHEME REVIEW

Consultation on a new scheme for Community Councils in Shetland was opened on 20th October and the SIC is asking for views and representations on five different proposals.
