		 APPROVE that the project, A New Campus in Brae for the North Mainland (The Brae Campus) remain incorporated into the Asset Investment Plan 2023-2028, on a provisional basis in the unfunded section, whilst reflecting the estimated cost of approximately £42.5m subject to approval of a Full Business Case.
		 APPROVE that the project proceed to Full Business Case in line with the Council's Gateway Process for the Management of Capital Projects Full Business Case.
		 APPROVE Shetland Islands Council's involvement in the North Programme Approach (Appendix 2 of the report), which would involve project resource through Hub North Scotland to enable this to proceed to the full business case. The estimated £4.5m indicative cost is included within the overall estimated cost of £42.5m.
