

**SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCIL
(LERWICK CENTRAL) (20 MILES PER HOUR ZONE)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER P22/2024**

NOTICE is hereby given that SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCIL propose to make the above named Order under Section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

1. The general effect of the proposed Order is that no person shall drive, cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding TWENTY MILES PER HOUR on all residential and local access roads in the central part of Lerwick east of Sea Road, Staneyhill and Holmsgarth. For avoidance of doubt, the existing 30mph limits along the following roads will remain:-
 - a. A970 South Road
 - b. A970 South Lochside
 - c. A970 North Lochside
 - d. A970 North Road
 - e. A970 Holmsgarth Road
 - f. A969 North Road (from A970 North Lochside eastwards to Burgh Road)
 - g. A969 Commercial Road from Burgh Road eastwards to King Harald Street
 - h. King Harald Street from A969 Commercial Road southwards to A969 Scalloway Road
 - i. A969 Scalloway Road westwards from King Harald Street to Burgh Road
 - j. A969 South Road
2. A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road affected and the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the Roads Service Offices, Gremista, Lerwick ZE1 0PX during normal office hours. Details will also be published on the Council web site.
3. Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order must send an objection in writing to the undersigned by 10 January 2025. Objections should state the name and address of the objector, the matter to which their objections relate, and the grounds on which they are made.
