24/71 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

24/72 MINUTE

The Minute of the meeting held on 30th September 2024 was adopted on the motion of Aileen

24/73 FINANCE AND GRANT APPLICATIONS

- 1) Community Council Annual Accounts:** The annual accounts had been prepared by Voluntary Action Shetland and were unanimously approved. The Clerk reported that the accounts had also been examined by Michael Duncan, SIC who had reported that he was satisfied that the Core Funding had been fully allocated, however, the Community Development Fund allocation had been underspent by £315 and therefore this amount must be repaid to the SIC.

24/73 FINANCE AND GRANT APPLICATIONS (Continued)

- 2) Southend Under 5's – To provide a Christmas Party with a small gift for each child, food, crafts etc for the local under 5's:** It was agreed, on the motion of Fiona, seconded by Irvine, to award the sum of £300. Although the members had agreed to award some funding towards the party once more, they felt that the group should investigate more sustainable ways of funding this event going forward as parties are not the type of event the Community Council usually funds.
- 3) SCBF – South Mainland Amateur Swimming Club – Funding towards reducing the cost of race entry fees:** The members unanimously agreed to support this application.
- 4) Bigton Community Shop – Car Park Improvements:** The Bigton Shop are hoping to carry out improvements to their car parking area. The works are estimated to cost up to £20,000, which they hope to be able to fund through the rural retail grant scheme and funding from the Community Council. However, the rural retail grant scheme will only cover up to a maximum of £10,000, leaving a large shortfall which the Community Council would not be in a position to assist with. It was agreed that SCBF might be a source of funding and SIC Community Development could also assist with identifying possible sources of funding.

24/74 PLANNING APPLICATIONS AND PLANNING MATTERS

- 1) 2024/255/PPF: To erect single storey dwellinghouse and install air source heat pump; create new access road, parking and turning; install new surface water soakaway, West of Hayhull Place, Bigton by Magnus Sandison & Karis Young –** There were no objections.
- 2) 2024/256/PPF: To erect timber clad shed on a concrete foundation to be used as a workshop & craft shop, Greenacres, Brake, Quendale by Mrs Lucinda Winks –** It was noted that the application states that visitors will be welcomed by appointment only hereby minimising the number of vehicles & visitors on the property at any one time. There were no objections.
- 3) 2024/252/PPF: To erect single storey extension to existing dwellinghouse, change of use of land to site extension and incorporate as garden ground, Movine, Willtrow, Dunrossness by Mr Dawid Lewandowski –** There were no objections.
