

CPPBT01: Trondra Farm

Difficulty: easy

CPPBT02: Meal Beach and Hamnavoe Circular

Difficulty: moderate
 Surface: boardwalk over boggy grass then rocks down to a sandy beach, followed by grass and a tarred road.
 Attraction: sandy beach and community walk
 Designation: NSA

CPPBT03: Caudhame to Burra Bridge Coastal

Difficulty: moderate to locally challenging
 Surface: grass and single track road
 Attraction: community route, coastal scenery
 Designation: NSA

CPPBT04: Bannamin Beach

Difficulty: easy to moderate
 Surface: gravel track leading to sandy beach
 Attraction: sandy beach popular with visitors and locals alike
 Designation: NSA

CPPBT05: Symbister

Difficulty: moderate to locally challenging
 Surface: grass
 Attraction: scenery, crofting remains and archaeological sites
 Designation: NSA





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


