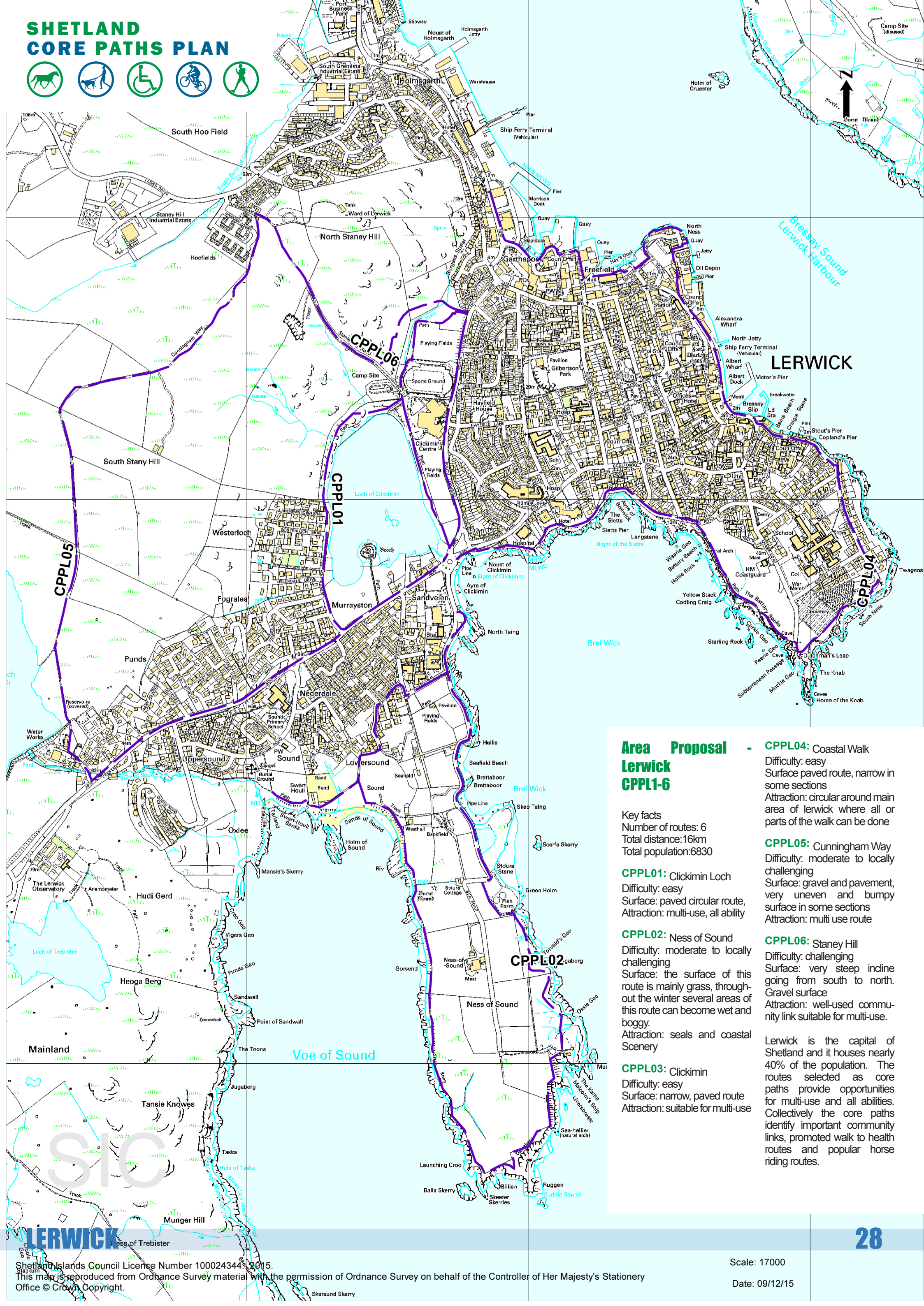


SHETLAND

CPPL1-6

Key facts  
Number of routes: 6  
Total distance: 16km  
Total population: 6830

**CPPL01:** Clickimin Loch  
Difficulty: easy  
Surface: paved circular route,  
Attraction: multi-use, all ability

**CPPL02:** Ness of Sound  
Difficulty: moderate to locally  
challenging  
Surface: the surface of this  
route is mainly grass, through-  
out the winter several areas of  
this route can become wet and  
boggy.  
Attraction: seals and coastal  
Scenery

**CPPL03:** Clickimin  
Difficulty: easy  
Surface: narrow, paved route  
Attraction: suitable for multi-use

**CPPL04:** Coastal Walk  
Difficulty: easy  
Surface paved route, narrow in  
some sections  
Attraction: circular around main  
area of Lerwick where all or  
parts of the walk can be done

**CPPL05:** Cunningham Way  
Difficulty: moderate to locally  
challenging  
Surface: gravel and pavement,  
very uneven and bumpy  
surface in some sections  
Attraction: multi use route

**CPPL06:** Staney Hill  
Difficulty: challenging  
Surface: very steep incline  
going from south to north.  
Gravel surface  
Attraction: well-used commu-  
nity link suitable for multi-use.

Lerwick is the capital of  
Shetland and it houses nearly  
40% of the population. The  
routes selected as core  
paths provide opportunities  
for multi-use and all abilities.  
Collectively the core paths  
identify important community  
links, promoted walk to health  
routes and popular horse  
riding routes.
