

CPPNL04: Stones of Stofast to Lunn Ness
 Difficulty: moderate to challenging
 Surface: rocky, grassy and heather
 Attraction: coastal route famous for its geological features, birds, otters and North Sea oil pipeline coming ashore. It also holds interesting flora and fauna and archaeological sites
 Designations: SAC, SSSI






