Notice to Mariners – Covid-19 Restrictions and Marine Leisure Activities - No 07/2020

All mariners are advised that the restrictions on recreational craft owners introduced by the Government on 23rd March 2020 have now been relaxed and amended by new advice issued. To reflect these changes introduced by the Scottish Government in Phase 1, dated 28th May 2020 this Notice to Mariners 07/2020 replaces the previous Notice 06/2020 in its entirety.

Unrestricted outdoors exercise and **non-contact outdoor** activities (including water sports & angling) in the local area are allowed from today (29 May), whilst adhering to social distancing measures.

Ancillary activities such as boat lifting will remain restricted subject to submission of lifting plans and risk assessments.

Operation of facilities in support of commercial craft are not affected by the current measures.
